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TERRA Curriculum for schools on prevention of radicalisation

The lesson material against radicalisation for high schools has combined 2 knowledge domains, that of radicalisation and that of citizenship education. Connecting both worlds has delivered new and unique material with lesson material and workshops for teachers who can use this in the class room. The material is a primary prevention intervention from which all students can profit. The material is aimed at issues like multiple identities, positive identity, mindfulness and emotional control, group pressure, assertiveness, conflict resolution stereotypes and prejudice, perspective taking, critical open-mindedness, critical thinking, political self-efficacy, and political empowerment.

Because it is primary prevention the risk of scapegoating in the classroom is avoided. It also makes it easier for schools to include it into their program as citizenship education.
